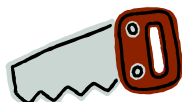

#### Greetings to all,

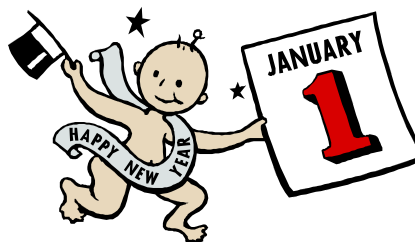

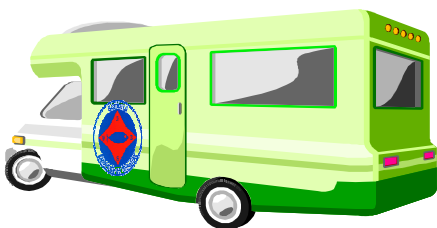

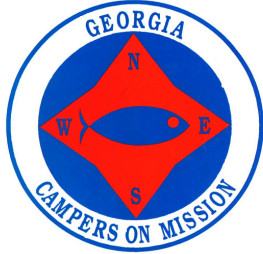
